Investment Objective

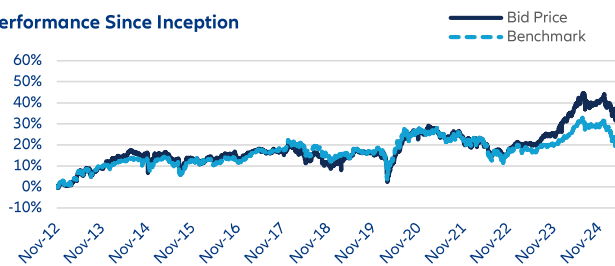

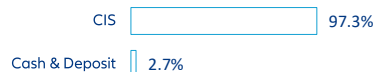
