

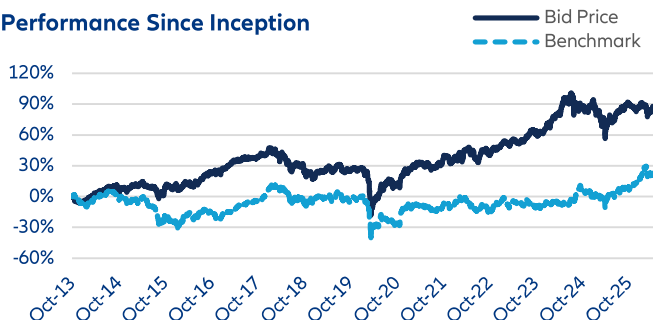
# Allianz Life Master ASEAN Plus Fund

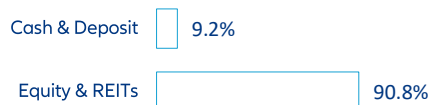
## Investment Objective
