Dierdre 'walks over' to her first Allianz Junior Badminton Championship (AJBC) 2024

Kota Kinabalu, 7 August 2024 – Deirdre Gianna Michael clinched her first Allianz Junior Badminton Championship (AJBC) 2024 U-15 Girls' Singles title in an interesting fashion – highlighted by walkovers on not only her opponents but also to her own partner!

Firstly, the 14-year-old suffered a walkover when her partner in the quarterfinals of the U-15 Girls' Doubles, Jessie Aegidius did not show up due to personal reasons. Then the following day, Deirdre was awarded a walkover in the semifinals of the U-15 Girls' Singles when her opponent Clarylyn Ashebelle did not turn up for their match.

All these side 'antics' did not deter her from winning the Girls' U-15 Singles title, beating Siti Nur Hanisah in the final. "It was quite a roller coaster tournament for me. I was really disappointed when I could not play the doubles quarterfinals, as I know that we could have at least made the final but she had some personal issues to attend to," said the Form Two student of SMK Tamparuli.

"However, getting a walkover in the singles semifinals meant that I'm at my maximum strength in the final. So, it sort of balanced things out for me," she added.

Jack Yak from Yu Yuan Secondary School and Low Kai Ling from Kuen Cheng High School emerged as big winners in their respective categories for AJBC Qualifying Round 6 which was held in Kota Kinabalu. Together with schoolmate Kerwin Soh, Jack bagged both Boys' U-15 singles and doubles while Kai Ling achieved a similar result in the Girls' U-13 category.

Last year, over 2,500 players participated in AJBC and entries are expected to rise to 3,000 this year in the 10 Qualifying Rounds. The remaining Qualifying Rounds will be staged in various venues around the country such Kluang, Pengkalan Chepa, Bukit Beruang and Kuantan.

The AJBC Grand Finals, featuring Under-13 and Under-15 finalists from all the Qualifying Rounds, will take place at Stadium Juara in Bukit Kiara from 20–25 November. Each round will see 24 players qualifying for the finals. The Under-11 players will not advance to the AJBC Grand Finals.

As in previous years, players participating in the AJBC Qualifying Rounds do not have to pay any entrance fees. The top three winners in the Qualifying Rounds, for all age categories, will earn RM500, RM300 and RM150 (singles) and RM600, RM400 and RM200 (doubles). Players finishing



in the top three at the Grand Finals will pocket RM1,000, RM600 and RM300 (singles) and RM1,200, RM800 and RM400 (doubles).
