The reward tiers under Allianz EV EcoMiles are as follows:

- Tier 1: Customers with an annual average mileage of up to 10,000 kilometres will receive a cash reward of 15% of their net basic premium (basic premium after deduction of the No Claim Discount (NCD)).
- Tier 2: Customers with an annual average mileage between 10,001 and 15,000 kilometres will receive a cash reward of 10% of their net basic premium (basic premium after deduction of the NCD).

To receive the cash reward, policyholders must activate Allianz EV EcoMiles in the MyAllianz mobile app within 30 days of the policy's effective date. Following this, they are to submit their odometer reading and vehicle photos in the app within 14 days before or after the policy expiry date. Once the submission is approved, the cash reward will be credited to the policyholder's account.

They will then receive a redemption code for the complimentary charging credit via email and the code can be redeemed via the ChargEV app by Yinson Greentech.
